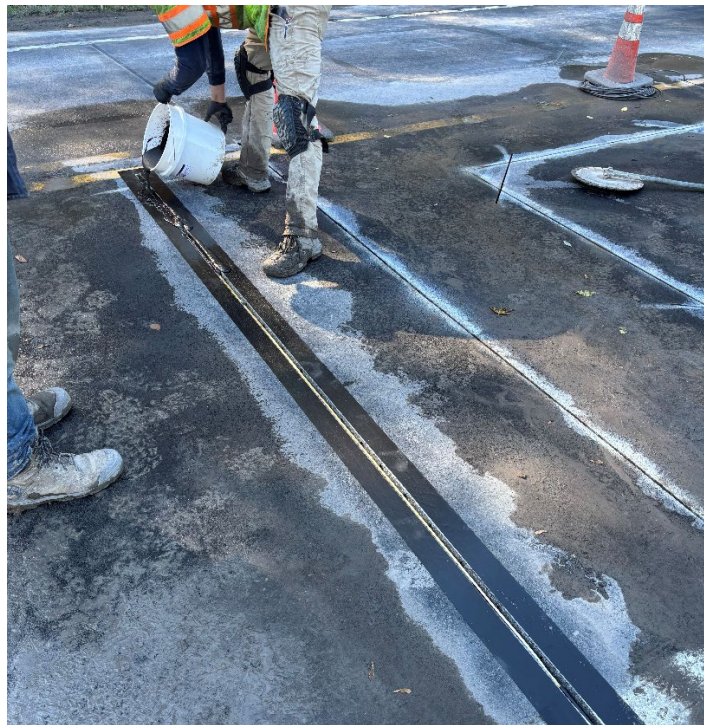


## New Developments

### Permanent Site Installations

Nineteen Continuous Automatic Vehicle Classification (CAVC) sites were reinstalled in the 2025 calendar year. A list of the sites is below, showing their location and when the site began collecting data.
