Example: 0.1 miles = 0.16 Kilometers or (0.2); 0.2 miles = 0.32 Kilometers or (0.3); 0.3 miles = 0.48 Kilometers or (0.5). Some conversions may not be shown in complete areas. The examples above are for use in determining the metric distance.
